


Strengthening Water Information and monitoring in the Mediterranean

- ➤ Improving National water data systems in coherence with international standards
 - > Organizational settings, local governance and legal framework
 - > Water data master planning
 - > Fund raising
 - > Implementation, training and operation
- Coordinating data collection mechanisms
 - ➤ Harmonisation of definitions (interoperability), guidelines, templates for Terms of references
 - > Fostering National Water Information Systems as main source of reliable data
 - ➤ Capacity building and training
 - > Exchange of experiences
