#### **MSSD Development**

- 12<sup>th</sup> CPs. Meeting decided to prepare the MSSD
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Euro-Med Environment Ministers (Athens 2002) endorsed the initiative
- Announced at the WSSD Johannesburg 2002
- MCSD acknowledged as the appropriate framework to develop the MSSD





#### **MSSD**

- Strengthens solidarity between North and South of the Mediterranean
- Leads decision makers to implement NSSDs
- Reinforces partnerships between countries, communities, civil society
- Based on assumption of that it constitutes the expression of the CPs. determination towards SD





### Three challenges

- The environmental challenge environmental degradation
- Demographic economic and social challenge
- The challenge of globalization, regional cooperation and governance





# Strategy is based on three interdependent pillars:-

- 1. Economic growth job creation, poverty alleviation
- 2. Social equity improved standard of living, access to essential services, availability of financial resources
- 3. Protection of the environment





#### Four Major Objectives of the Strategy

- Contribute to economic development by enhancing Mediterranean assets
- Reduce social disparities by implementing the MDGs
- Change unsustainable production and consumption patterns and ensure sustainable management of natural resources
- Improve governance at local, national and regional level





### Achieving Progress in Seven Essential Issues

To help meet the four objectives the strategy promotes progress in seven essential issues:-

- water resources and demands
- energy demand and climate change
- mobility and transport management
- tourism as leading economic sector
- quality agriculture and rural development
- urban development
- sea, coastal areas and marine resources





#### Why these fields of action?

- Most threatened by unsustainable trends
- Important fields on the economic and social level with potential for improvement
- Manifest shortcomings in governance and integration that need to be corrected





### Improving integrated water management Objectives

- Stabilize water demand
- Promote integrated management of watersheds

# Improving integrated water management Actions

- Regional cooperation: MAP, EUWI
- Sectoral water demand management
- Encourage investments in demand side water management and appropriate financial mechanisms
- Integrated water resource management: legal, Institutional and technical





## Improving integrated water management Actions

- Access to water and sanitation: MDGs and investments in WWTPs
- Water management governance: Participatory approach
- Sustainable Agriculture : reduction of consumption of water
- Sustainable urban development:treatment of wastewater according to SAP





## Improving integrated water management Actions

- Promote sustainable management of the sea:
  - promoting ICZM
  - Preventing and reducing pollution from ships
  - Preventing and reducing pollution from LBS





#### Implementation strategy

- Solidarity and commitments: EMP, MAP, MEAs...
- Sub regional approach: Adriatic Initiative
- Strengthening capacities, involve actors and financial resources: education,research,donors,restructuring of national spending,private sector, economic instruments
- National strategies: NSSDs
- Monitoring through indicators





#### **NSSD**

- Build on MSSD
- Egypt , Montenegro , Morocco , Syria finalized their NSSDs in 2005
- Albania , Bosnia-Herzegovina , Lebanon , Tunisia launched the preparation process in 2006.





#### Monitoring

- 34 priority indicators
- 9 priority indicators related to water sectors
- 3 additional indicators related to water sectors
