

# The integrated water resource and water demand management...

- The 1<sup>st</sup> priority field of action of the Mediterranean Strategy for Sustainable Development
- 4 main objectives :
- To stabilize water demand through the reduction of water losses and the wasteful use of water and increase the added value per m³ of water used,
- To promote the integrated management of watersheds and eco-systems,
- To achieve the Millennium Development Goals concerning access to safe drinking water and sanitation,
- To promote participation, partnership & cooperation for the sustainable management of water at local and national level.


