

# **NEW SITUATION**

- □ European Commission providing a limited coverage of European Mediterranean Water Information System (EMWIS) activities (2008-2010)
- □ Context of global financial crisis➤ Governmental budget reduced
- □ More systematic competitive procedures for European Commission grants
- □ Other regional activities covered by European Mediterranean Water Information System (EMWIS) Technical Unit countries (France, Italy and Spain)

- Geographical area: focusing on regions boardering the Mediterranean see from countries who signed a cooperation agreement for this program: Jordan, Syria, Tunisia, Egypt, Israel, Lebanon, Palestine (+Italy, Cyprus, Malta, Greece, France, Spain)
- Typical project funding: 500 000 to 2 millions Euros with at least 3 countries
- Priority 2 d). Promotion of environmental sustainability:
  - □ at the basin level through the prevention and reduction of risk factors for the environment

# Strategic Projects

- Overall budget: € 37.000.000
- Indicative launch date: December 2010/early 2011
- Programme website: www.enpicbcmed.eu
- Geographical area: focusing on regions boardering the Mediterranean see from countries who signed a cooperation agreement for this program: Jordan, Syria, Tunisia, Egypt, Israel, Lebanon, Palestine (+Italy, Cyprus, Malta, Greece, France, Spain)
- Typical project funding: 2 to 5 millions Euros (90%) with at least 4 countries
- Priority 2 d). Water management with attention on:
  - ☐ Quantity and quality of supply, with a focus on alternative water supplies and wastewater re-use and/or
  - ☐ Efficient use of water resources, with a focus on agricultural use.



#### **ENPI SWM-DM**



- Overall budget: € 15.000.000
- Indicative launch date: December 2010/early 2011
- Geographical area: All the Euromed countries
- Typical project funding: up to 1.5 millions Euros (90%)
- Priority on:
  - □ Sustainable water management policies, water scarcity, desertification processes, in connection with climate change
