Upgrading Internet connections (1/2)

- **Objective:**
 - Improving the Internet connectivity for the operation of EMWIS
- **Solution to be implemented in 2002**
 - 10 countries
 - Budget of 100 000 Euro
 - Contractual constraints: EC procurement rules
- **Operational constraints**
 - The NFP server must be operational
 - The upgrade must improve the Internet access to the EMWIS servers



Upgrading Internet connections (2/2)

➤ Proposed procedure

- The NFP asks local providers for a technical and commercial solution following EC procurement rules
- Validation of the solution by the Technical Unit
- Contract between the operator and the Technical Unit
- Set-up of the solution by the operator
- Formal validation of set-up and operation by the NFP
- Payment by the Technical Unit

➤ Approval request in process for:

- Algeria, Jordan and Turkey

➤ Deadline: 31 December 2002

Sustainability study

(Distributed during the seminar of Directors)

- **EMWIS offers good technical basis for further development**
- **Strong commitment from the Med countries**
- **EMWIS is a good channel for disseminating MEDA-Water information**
- **Public sector financing is necessary:**
 - Rules of the public sector
 - Not yet enough developed to attract private funding
- **National uses have to be reinforced**



Development of common access to available information

- **Multilingual and multi-bases tools operational:**
 - Format of the databases: Z3950 (version 2)
 - Hispagua documentation subsets (ES) –local server-
 - EauDoc subsets (FR) – remote server-
- **Other identified documentation databases available for EMWIS:**
 - WaterNet (JO and PS)
 - ELMADOC.DZ (DZ)
- **Others to be identified**



EMWIS meetings (1999-2002)

MEDA-Water – EMWIS role

- **Dissemination of information**
 - Call for proposals published on EMWIS web sites
 - Electronic flashes to more than 1500 subscribers
- **Support for project preparation**
 - Partners identification
 - Electronic forum for declaration of interest
 - Identification of national priorities
- **Exchange of information and know-how from projects**



Role of MEDA Facilitators

- Dissemination of information on the ‘Call for Proposals’ and on national policies and programming.
- Promotion of public, private and civil society awareness and capacity building in the framework of funded projects and in co-ordination with implementing partners.
- Provide the interface for the assimilation of the results and impact of the Euro-Mediterranean Regional Water Programme within future national and regional dialogue on water sector planning.

- **Meeting of Water Director General, Nov'01, Madrid**
 - EMWIS Strategic Plan 2002-2005
- **Technical evaluation of EMWIS by independent experts, March-June'02**
 - Recommendations to the EC and the T.U.
- **Monitoring of contract, June'02**
 - Recommendations to the EC and the T.U.
- **Enhancement of the Strategic Plan, Sept'02**
- **Steering Committee meeting, Sept'02, Rome**
- **Technical and financial proposal to the EC**

Main lessons from Phase 1 Positive results



- A unique regional initiative of the Euro-Med Partnership in the water sector
- Real momentum initiated in the Med Countries
- An organisational structure up and running
 - 20 NFP, Steering Committee, Technical Unit
- An operational technical platform

Main lessons from Phase 1

Some limitations



- New national needs and requirements are emerging
- Lack of knowledge of user needs
- Lack of flexibility of the technical architecture for a wider integration of
- Necessity to reinforce the promotion
- More content is required, e.g. lack of regional analysis
- Sustainability must be ensured
 - by integrated EMWIS as an institutional system in each country and at the international level
