What funding for EMWIS?

Some facts:

- The end of the contract with the EC at the end of June 2008
- EMWIS TU is maintained financially by: OIEAU, CEDEX, SOGESID & DG-ENV/WISE (2 small contracts)
- No funds for EMWIS NFPs (expects covering travels for EMWIS seminars and WGs and the possibility to fund some NWIS launches)
- The Union for the Mediterranean process is suspended, but water experts group will meet in this month
- Some regional call for proposals are launched: Possibility of applying for EMWIS & its NFPs?
- Bilateral cooperation or twining actions: possibilities of funding for EMWIS NFPs (NWIS, priority themes..)

- Typical project budget: 500 000 to 2 millions
