

# « Mediterranean water information partnership »

#### • Objective :

- Streamlining collection process of reliable information following needs
- Promoting data identification (metadata), availability and enhancement
- Supporting the countries in the development of their Information System
- Facilitating exchange of comparable and quality data and information, between national and regional organisations, especially through the promotion of common processes and language
- Promoting the exchange of experiences between Mediterranean countries
- Strengthening synergies and collaboration between organisations and regional think tanks regarding data management and enhancement
- Under the Political framework of Water Directors committee
- **Topics covered**: Priority topic of MDG and MSSD but also any topic on water and sanitation and on uses and associated socioeconomic aspects, following needs



# Principle 1: Voluntary Participation

- No obligation of participation,
- Members are free to leave the partnership at any time,
- Openness to any organisation producing, administrating and/or using water data and information in the Mediterranean;
- At the international, national, regional or local level



## Principle 2: Added value for members

#### National

- Enhancement of data or indicators production with potential support of international organisations
- Capacity building for building/enhancing NWIS
- Regional/international organisations:
  - Easier access to better quality data
  - Coordination with other regional initiative collecting data
- Regional and national
  - Ability to launch/facilitate or participate in the work of the working groups with privileged access to the results of the various groups (shared documents, etc.);
  - Privileged access to the tools and methods available for developing its own activities (e.g. catalogues, reference frames, mapping, etc.);
  - Participation in workshops for the exchange of experience, and privileged access to training/information capacities and regular information on work progresses (info flash, etc.);



### Principle 3: Quality Insurance

- The producers will provide:
  - metadata
  - information on the completeness of the available data;
- Possibilities of internal "peer review" by the members to improve the quality of data produced



### Principle 4: Minimum commitments

- Producing metadata
- Sharing experiences
- Promoting the mechanism
- Specific contributions define case by case:
  - Each member defines the data and/or human resources and equipment (information system), which it wishes to share and/or develop within this partnership;
